Description: 50 Primary Schools, 25 Secondary & Professional Schools, 15 full-size high schools in all counties of the Republic of Cabinda in order to serve the national population education needs in all the extension of the territory.

Location: Cabinda City, Landana, Buco Zau, Belize, Chicamba, Miconje, Sango Mongo, Caio Guembo, Fubo, Zenze, Beira Nova, Dinge, Sassa Zau, Kakongo, Luclula, Baca, Tchinzaze, Lema, Buca, Malembo, Mau-Lelo, Vala, Viede, Tando Limbo, Chapa, Chiobo, Quissoqui, Lulia, Chipita and some other towns and villages in the rural interior of Cabinda.

Total combined project size: 3.450,000 square feet, 159 acres, 200000-250.000 students

Enrolments: 200.000 - 250.000 students. All schools will start with a freshmen class in their first year after completion.

Vision for the new Schools: In seeking to ensure that the new schools incorporate the vision of current needs, initial discussions with schools have taken place and these have produced some common principles.

These include:

- Flexible light airy teaching spaces
- Secure, easily managed, clearly defined, overlooked entrance/reception area
- Covered outside areas
- Specialist facilities areas.
- Appropriate secure storage areas
- Adequate secure car parking
- Sustainable heating and lighting systems
- Aesthetically pleasing design, to include green areas
- Circulation areas that do not disrupt classes
- Designed accommodation that promotes well-being for students, tutors and staff.
- Estimated time of completions from start of construction: 24 Months
- Total estimate cost on time and on budget: US\$90.000.000
